Our Company has contributed Rs. 13.59 Lakh to Blind People's Association as part of the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), for the project "Establishment of Comprehensive Vision Centre" at Mehemdabad for the FY 2019-20.

The objectives of the centre are.....

- Identification of patients with various eye elements including patients' needs surgical intervention
- Treatment of minor eye elements
- Conducting school screening camp and providing spectacle to the needy children
- Counselling of patient's
- In time Follow-up of the operating patients and provide number of follow-up followed by refractive correction for better surgical outcome.
- Spectacle dispensing
- Creating a friendly atmosphere regarding the organization in the community
- Local level community eye screening camp, treatment of minor eye elements, and provision of spectacle and identifying patients need surgical intervention in the camp and arrange transfer the patients' needs surgical intervention to base hospital.

The Netra Sarvar Kendra has been started at Mahemadabad from 16th June, 2020. Keeping in view the situation of Covid - 19, the centre is functional thrice a week (Every Monday, Thursday and Saturday).

Every month, around 300 patients visit the centre.

This center is equipped with basic ophthalmic equipment like Slit Lamp, Streak Retinoscope, Direct Ophthalmoscope, Trial sets, Schiotz Tonometer, Basic sterilizers, BP apparatus and 90D Lens and a computer with a digital camera. The centre is run by well-trained ophthalmic technician or optometrist who performs slit lamp examination, refraction, treating minor ailments like foreign body removal, counselling etc. Any vision centre is linked with Navalbhai and

Hiraba Eye hospital of Blind People's Association for consultation and also to access secondary or tertiary level eye care.

Patients who require procedural intervention are asked to come to the hospital. The vision centre work closely with the community through community workers who create awareness about the eye problems in the community. In addition to the vision centre technician, a coordinator is posted to look after non-clinical activities such as registration, maintenance of records, statistics and interaction with various stakeholders like outreach manager, outreach organizer and field workers.

The vision centre has access to all the patients need eye care facilities and patients need surgical intervention will be brought for the same. But priority will be given to old age, women, children and poor people from any caste or creed.
